Indian Trails takes delivery of seven 2010 PrevoSt H3-45s

Sainte-Claire, QC, February 10, 2010 – Indian Trails, Inc., a leading U.S. coach operator headquartered in Owosso, Michigan, recently took delivery of seven new PrevoSt H3-45 coaches.

Indian Trails serves a diverse customer base, providing charter, tour, shuttle, and airport transportation as well as daily scheduled service to Chicago and Milwaukee. The company, which has been family owned for three generations, employs 125 and will observe its 100th anniversary this year.

In its earliest days, Indian Trails' pioneering owners actually built some of their first buses themselves. Today a fleet of 62 vehicles—with nearly half of the charter coaches being PrevoSt—carries over 750,000 passengers per year.

The seven most recent additions to the fleet took to the highway in late 2009. Chad Cushman, Vice President Business, commented that Indian Trails chose the H3-45 model not only because drivers enjoy its handling and passengers its comfort, but because it represents “the best coach and value for the money.” The new PrevoSts were ordered with Premier™ three-point belted seats, he added, which is “an example of our ongoing commitment to passenger safety. Taking a proactive approach and selecting equipment that’s on the cutting edge are part of our company tradition.”

The company’s founders would surely be impressed by the Indian Trails of today. It not only operates the largest coach fleet in Michigan, but also has its own state-of-the-art maintenance facilities, including a body shop. And one tradition established years ago by co-founder Cora Taylor, a history buff, endures: each vehicle that joins the Indian Trails fleet is christened with the name of a Native Indian chief who hailed from the central Michigan area.
